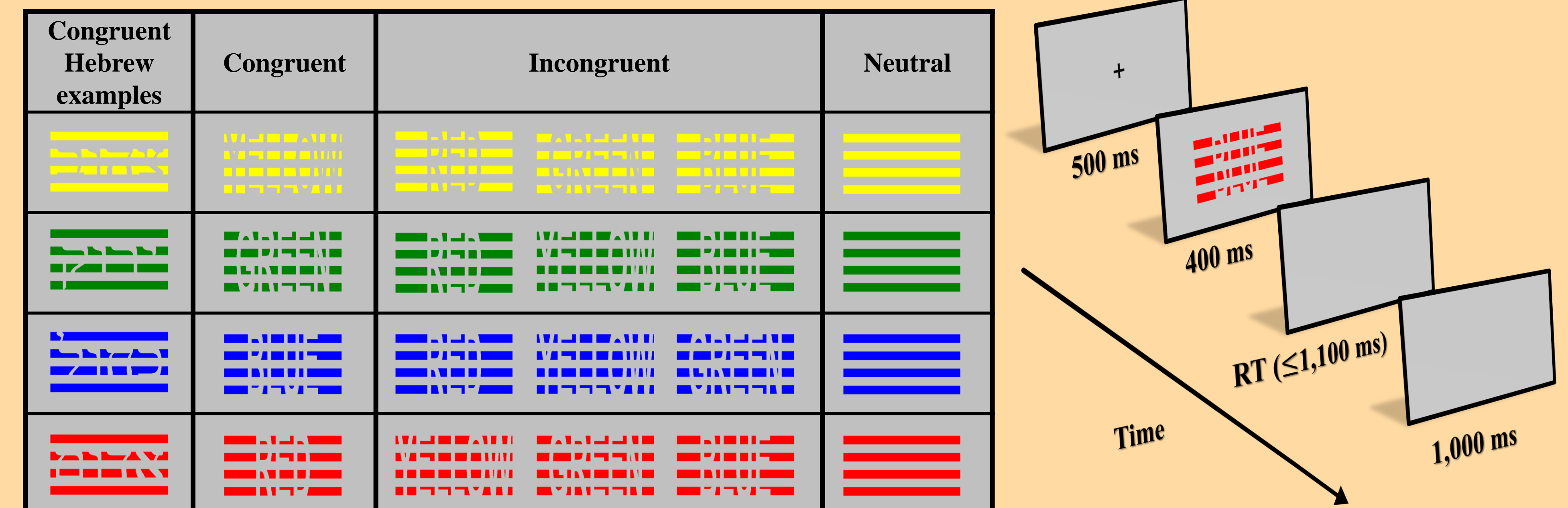

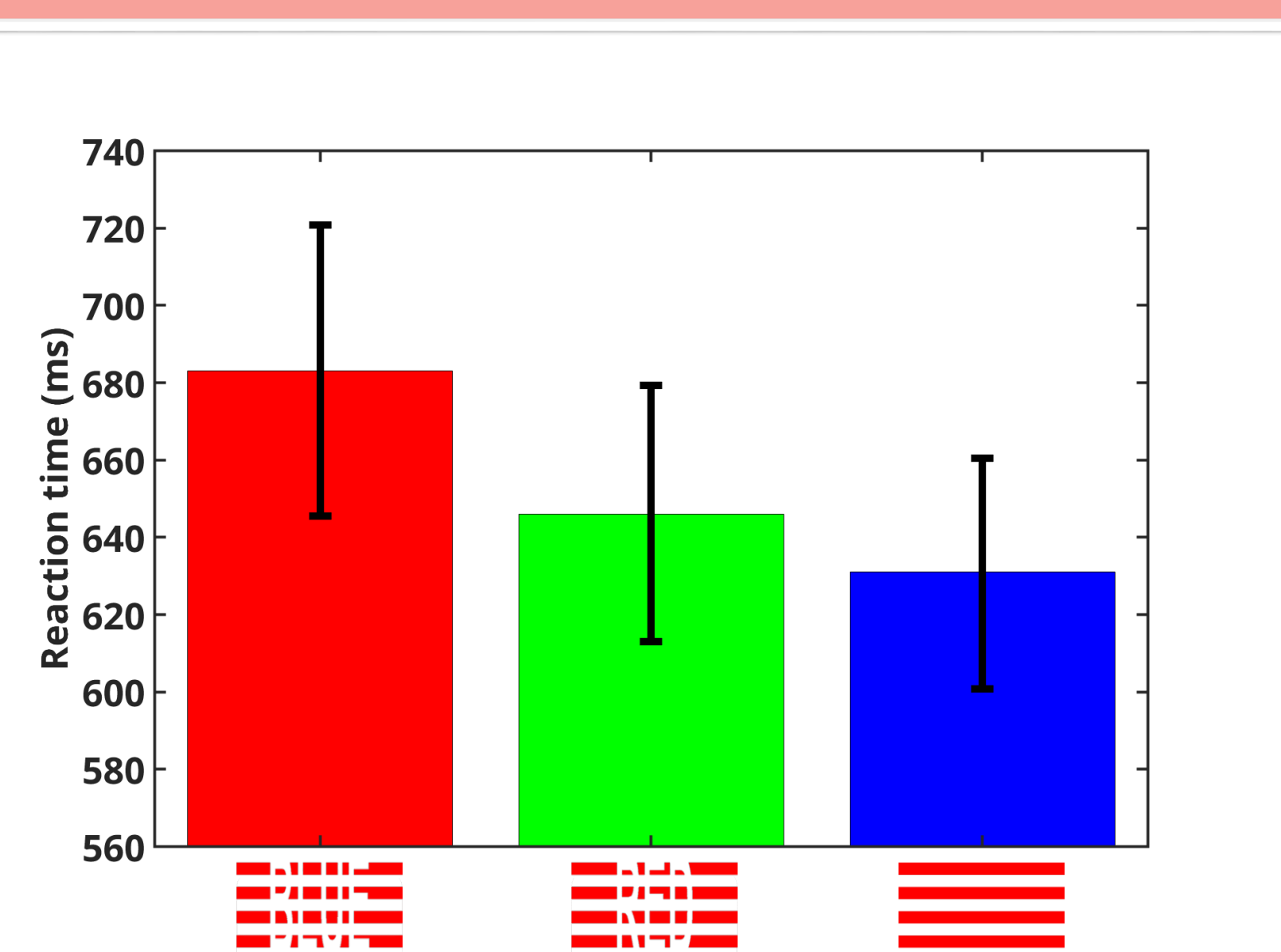

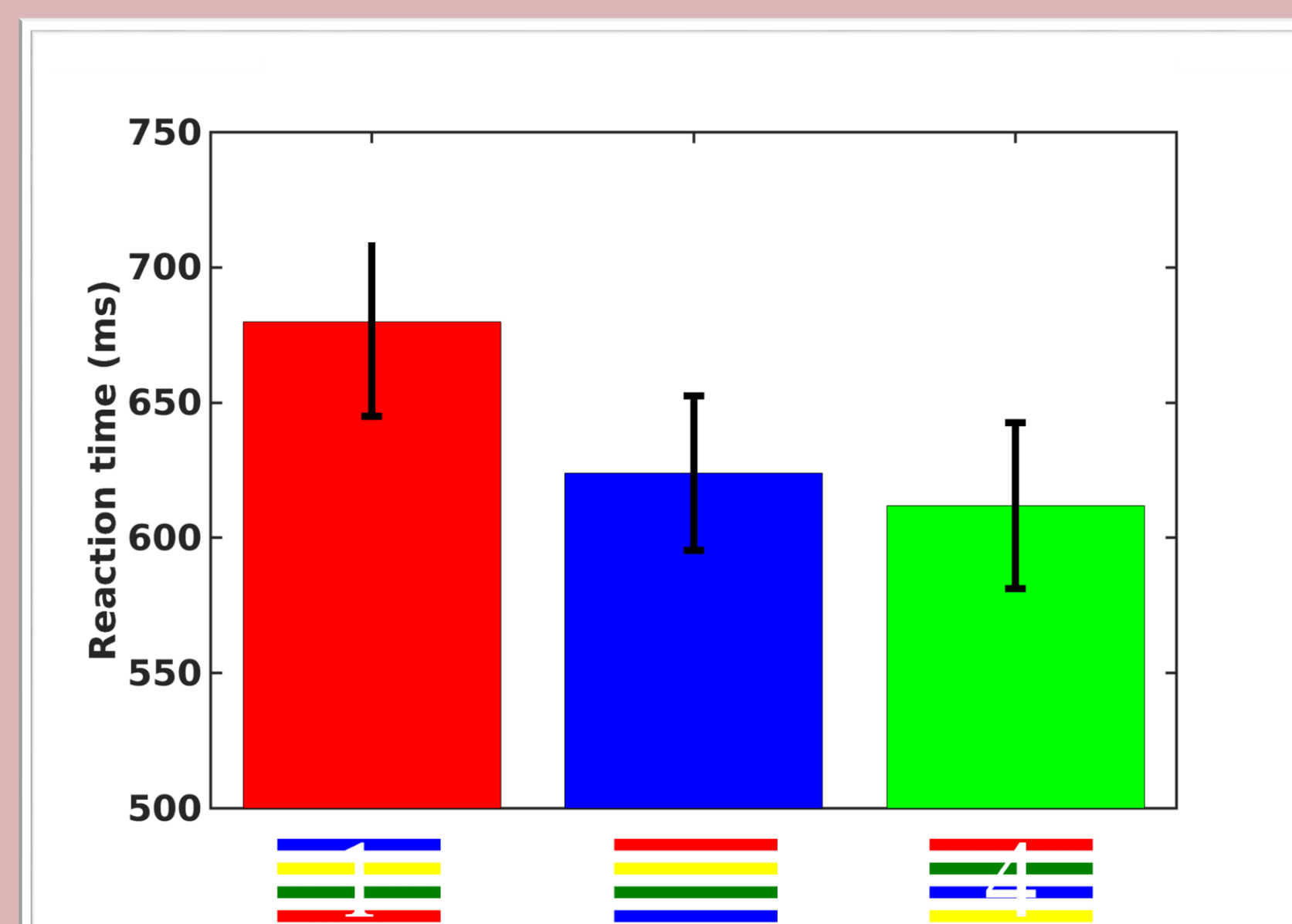

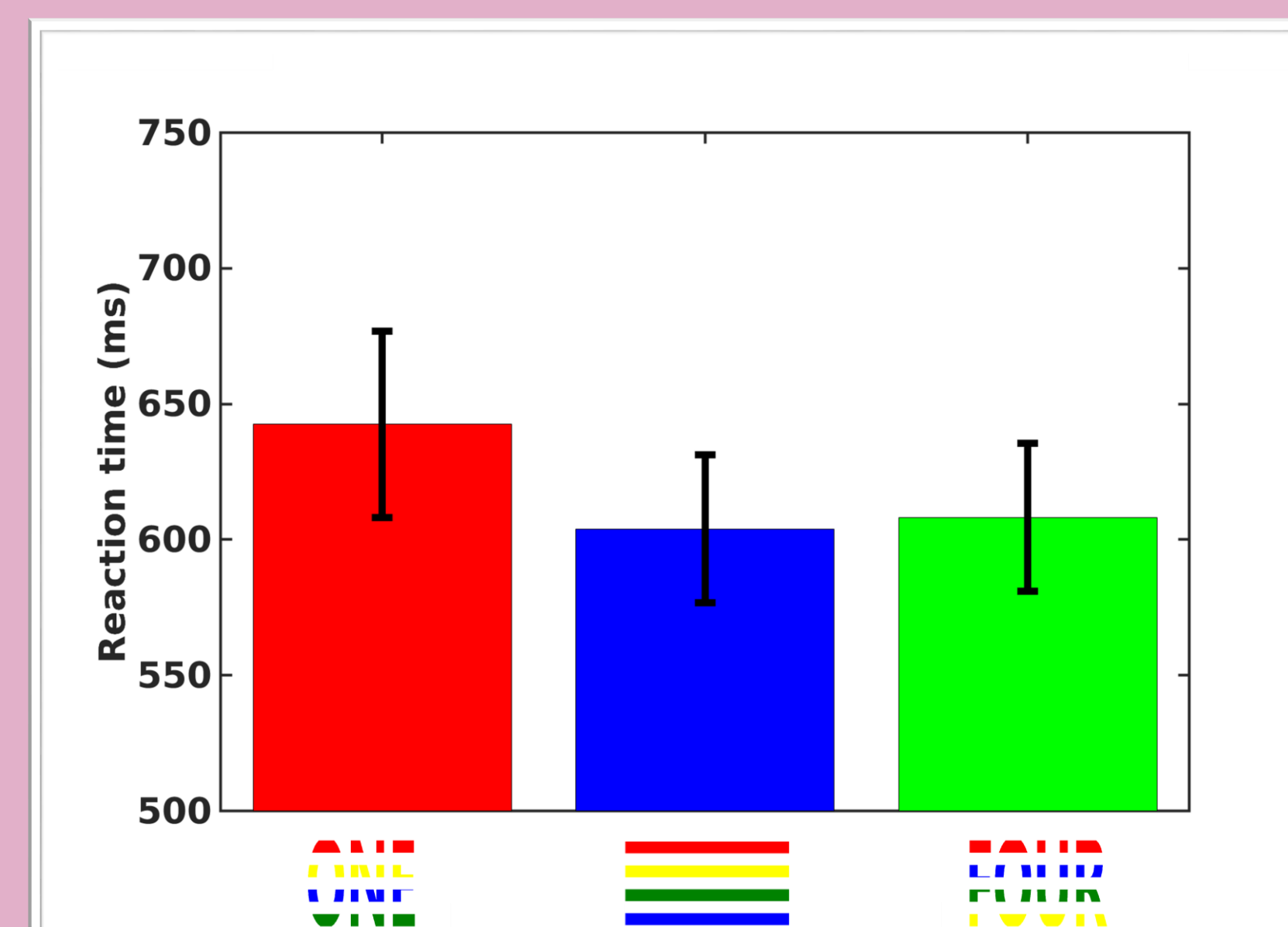
Results – color word



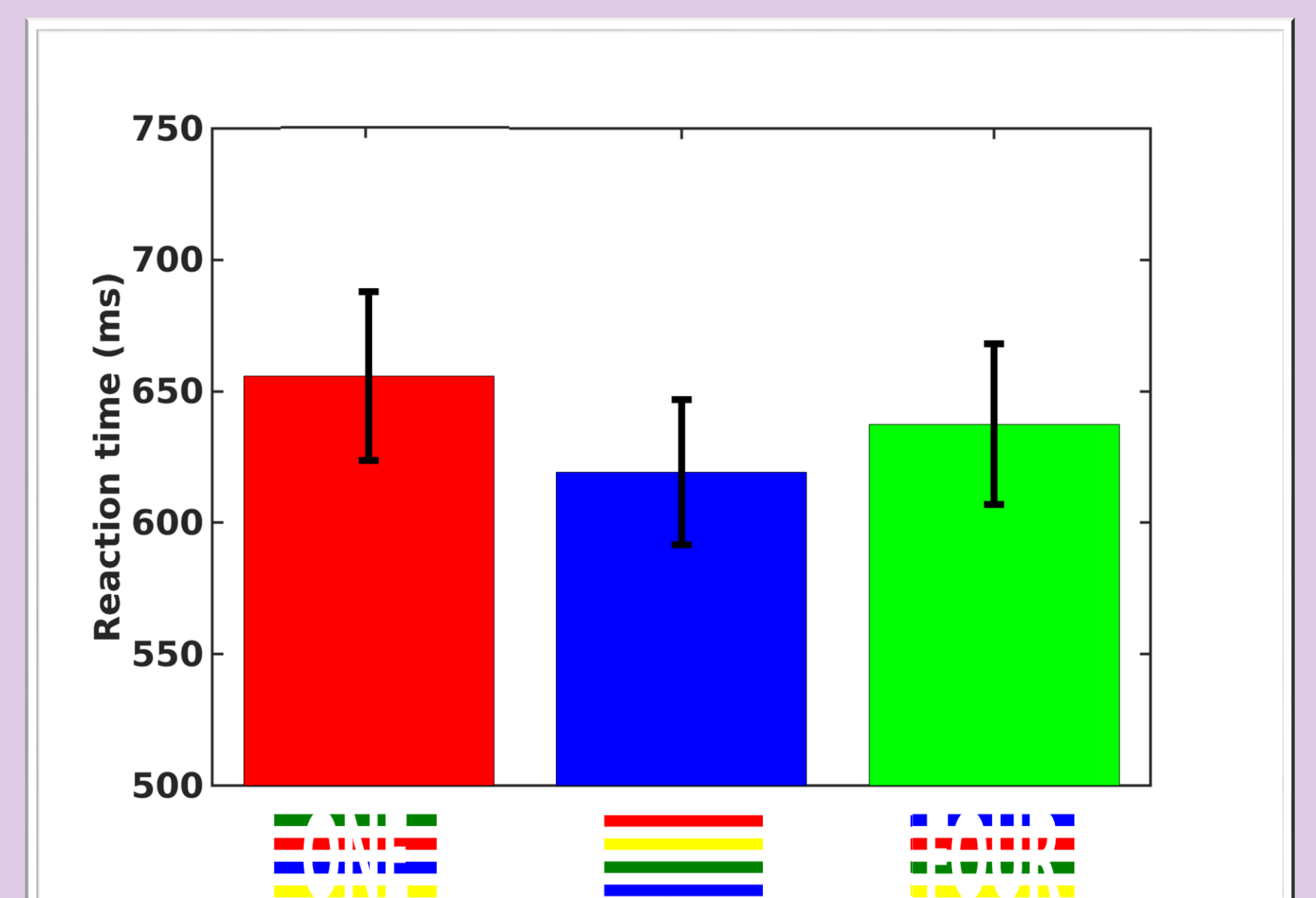
Results – color digit 1



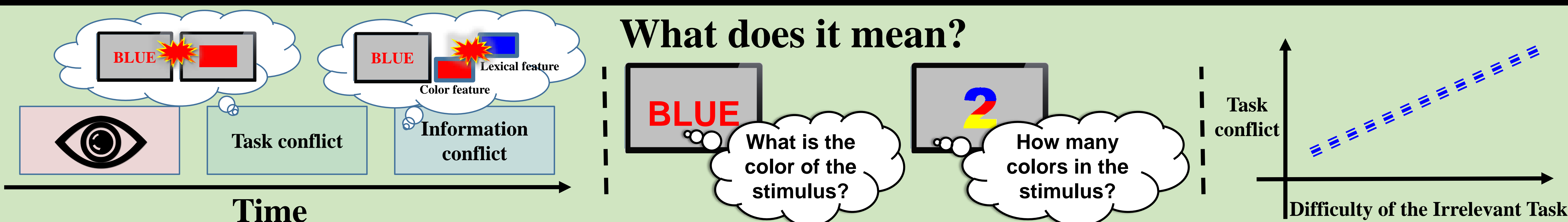
Results – color digit 2
